## Host city – New Delhi

New Delhi, the National Capital, is the heart of India. It is a fusion of the ancient and modern developments. It unwinds a picture rich with culture, architecture and human diversity. New Delhi is well connected with cities all over the world by air. It is also well connected to cities within India through air, rail, and road.

## Weather

The month of February is very pleasant. The temperature ranges from a maximum of 24 °C to a low of about 10 °C.

## Historical places of interest

- **India Gate:** A memorial raised in honour of the Indian soldiers who were martyred in the Second World War, famous as the All India War Memorial, designed by Edwin Lutyens in 1921, height 42 metres
- **Jama Masjid:** A mosque built by Shahjahan, which can accommodate 20 000 worshippers
- **Jantar Mantar:** An astronomical observatory with instruments built of stone by the great royal astronomer, Maharaja Jai Singh of Jaipur in 1724
- **Lotus Temple:** Situated atop Kalkaji Hill, also known as Baha'i Temple, completed in 1986
- **Qutab Minar:** An 11th century victory tower, the tallest (73 metres) stone tower in India
- **Raj Ghat:** Mahatma Gandhi, Father of the Nation, was cremated here in 1948
- **Rashtrapati Bhavan:** Official residence of the President of India. It also houses the world famous Mughal Garden, known for precious collection of seasonal flowers
- **Red Fort:** One of the most important forts in India, built in the 17th century, houses several private and public royal halls, mosques, and gates
